## **GENERAL AND OPTIONAL EXPENSES DURING THE YEAR**

The recommended amount to transfer on a High School's personal account is CHF 6,745.00 (six thousand seven hundred and forty-five Swiss francs). This estimated amount will normally cover the general expenses.

Some other possible expenses not included in this chart are transportation to and from the airport (and eventual accompaniment); transportation to and from medical appointments; school shop; damage to school material; dentist and medical glasses (not covered by the insurance).

(1) If the student does not cover these payments, she will lose the right to sit the exams.



#### STUDENT'S PRIVATE ACCOUNTS

To prevent too much cash in student's hands, for example before and during excursions and trips, and under some conditions (please see "conditions" hereunder), we will open a private account for each of our students, at the Union de Banques Suisses (UBS) in Montreux.

- 1. The student will receive a Maestro Card and a Code which will allow her, and for free:
  - ✓ To withdraw money in an ATM in Switzerland
  - ✓ To pay in shops and restaurants in a lot of countries
  - ✓ To see the balance of her private account on Internet

This card will allow her:

✓ To withdraw money in an ATM in other countries. Each direct debit will cost CHF 5.00.

This is not a credit card. So, it doesn't allow using more money that what is on the private account.

#### 2. Pocket money

- Each week, or every two weeks, we will wire onto each student's private account their pocket money.
- ✓ As the students will need a minimum of cash, we propose to give them, each week CHF 20.00 in cash.
- ✓ At the end of the school year, the private account will be closed. In order not to have accounts with small amounts (which means that they can't be closed) the eventual balance will be wired to Le Châtelard UBS account. We will of course reimburse this amount to the student, when closing their personal accounts, at the end of the annual course.

#### 3. Conditions

- ✓ For students over 15 years old and without relationship to the USA: we will be able to open a private account without any other documents than the copy of the passport.
- ✓ For the students with an American passport (even with another passport) or a green card we won't open a private account as the procedure is too long. Please note that if the student has only a residence in the USA but wasn't born in the USA and has no Green card, we will open a private account, as we only need a copy of her passport.
